



# RADNOR TRAIL HISTORICAL SIGNS

The sign that you see here tells the story of the Philadelphia & Western Railway, an electric railroad that once ran on the site of today's Radnor Trail. Two of these signs have been installed so far, part of a planned series of ten. They will be located at the sites of former railroad stations and other points of interest to educate Trail users about the history underneath their feet.
