PLASTIC METAL PAPER GLASS • Office paper (staples can be included) Bottles • Aluminum (beverage) cans • #1–7 plastic containers with neck • Newspapers, Magazines, Junk mail smaller than base Tars • Bimetallic (food) cans Paper bags • Broken glass (bottles and jars only) • Clean tin foil Bottles • Wax-coated cartons (e.g. milk, • Caps/lids off • Empty aerosol cans Jugs ice-cream cartons) • Caps/lids off • Don't crush • Cardboard (tape can be left on) • Don't crush • Boxboard (e.g. cereal, tissue boxes) YES! • Empty paper towel and toilet paper rolls Wrapping paper (basic) Paperback books • Foil and/or glitter wrapping paper • Plastic wrap (see back) Windows • Paint cans • Laminated paper Mirrors Utensils • Scrap metal • Drinking glasses • Waxy cardboard • Tubs and travs • Pie pans Food tainted items • Clothes hangers* • Lead crystal • Tupperware* • Ceramics • No plastic bags in bin • Tempered glass (e.g. Pyrex) NO! **DONATION ITEMS PLASTIC BAGS ELECTRONIC HAZARDOUS WASTE** • Hardback books Recycle at your local Whole Foods, • Lightbulbs • Propane cans • Cell phones, TV • Sporting goods Giant, Acme, Wegmans, or Styrofoam some Wawas.
